


VISION & DEVELOPMENT PRINCIPLES

A Vision for PR6a

PR6a will be a diverse and healthy mixed-use intergenerational community, providing essential housing for Oxford. It will be connected to its neighbours, to the city, and to nature and the countryside. A place that people value, where sustainability, wellbeing and quality of life are fundamental.

Stewardship
Ensure strong leadership and governance in the design process for PR6a, and create a lasting legacy.



Minimise carbon impacts
Reduce carbon in construction and operation, minimise energy consumption, and generate carbon-free energy.



Create a strong community
Put people first. Work with local people and stakeholders to co-create a genuine and inclusive community which gives all people a sense of belonging. Empower people to be in control.




Live healthily with nature


Workshop 2: Character and Identity



This is the largest quad in Oxford measuring 204 by 201 feet. Tom Quad was laid out in the mid 1500s.




